

## Children's ministry for 0 - 11s



We love having a heap of children at Leeds Vineyard and if you are 11 years old or younger, Vineyard Kids is for you! Our vision is to teach and equip children to follow Jesus. We love to do that in an environment where the children feel loved, valued and safe. Most of what we do happens on Sunday mornings, take a look at the various groups we have below. We want children to build wonderful memories of growing up in this community of faith.

### Roly Polys 0 - 3s

Roly Polys is suitable for babies that can sit (around 6 months old) up to children aged 3. Whilst crawling and toddling, playing and singing, dancing and jumping, the children are taught simple truths that God loves them and that they are special.

### Jumping Beans 3 - 5s

Jumping Beans is the place for 3 - 5 year olds to come and worship God. Through play, stories, crafts, games, songs, prayers and more, we learn about what it means to be a friend of God and how we can talk and listen to Him.

### Starjumps Years 1 - 2

The Starjumps are the Vineyard Kids in Years 1 - 2 at school. The Starjumps play games, make friends, look at the Bible, paint, make things and learn to follow Jesus.

### Connect Years 3 - 6

The Connect kids are the older part of Vineyard Kids. We have two groups, the first being for Years 3 - 4 and the second for Years 5 - 6. Through games, dramas, parties, worship, chats, painting, challenges and movies, the children learn about Jesus and how to follow Him in their everyday life.
