

Why do we Reach Out?

Our hope is to express Jesus' heart of mercy and His demand for justice to a broken world. We want to minister to the poor in practical ways and introduce people to Jesus. As a church, we expect the Lord to fill us with His

Often we read that Jesus had compassion - Matthew 9:36 *"When he saw the crowds, he had compassion on them..."*. Combined with obedience it seems to be the main driver behind his ministry.

Isaiah 61:1ff, *"The Spirit of the Sovereign Lord is upon me, because he has anointed me to preach good news to the poor. He has sent me to bind up the broken hearted, to proclaim freedom for the captives and release from darkness for the prisoners, to proclaim the year of the Lord's favour and the day of vengeance of our God."*

We prioritise the use of money, time and energy to express the values of mercy and compassion not only to each other but also outward into our community and beyond. As we understand what Jesus has done for us we want to demonstrate God's love to others.

Love God, Love People, Love in Action.

What do we do?

Our vision is for Leeds to be a vibrant, thriving city where the people we work with fulfil their personal, social, economic and spiritual potential.

Our main expression of this is:

- a child contact centre where children of separated parents can meet their non-resident parent or family member.

We also have:

- a Store of small household items and clothes.
- Gardening & Decorating teams (normally small groups) helping those who are referred to us for help.

The Vine This is no small task so in 2010 we set up a charity called the Vine to help us to achieve this vision. This enables us to run specific projects and to work with the council and funders more easily than we perhaps could as a church. The Vine has its own board of trustees and staff who are all part of, and work closely with Leeds Vineyard.



Ways to get involved

There are several ways we do this at the moment including: Healing on the Streets; a Treasure Hunting team who head out on the second Saturday of each month; the Doing the Stuff small group and an Alpha course which runs regularly in Costa Coffee. We aim to be known as good neighbours by all who call Headingley their home.

Reach Out Global

Jesus taught us to go make disciples of all nations and we are passionate about working alongside people from all backgrounds across the globe. Over the last few years people from Leeds Vineyard have been involved in overseas outreach in the following countries: Mexico, Latvia, South Africa, Kenya, Uganda, Zambia, Haiti, Dominican Republic, India, Bangladesh.

Long term our vision is to support the local church overseas through a partnership model.

We currently have mission partners Ivan & Libby Mungarro in Mexico, and others in Central Asia.
