Questions to ask before taking on debt:

- 1. Will you still have a cashflow surplus?
- Does taking on this debt meet a core goal that cannot be met in any other way?
- Is the benefit of taking out the loan less than the cost of repaying it?
- 4. Do you have a guaranteed way to repay the debt?
- 5. Do you have peace of mind?
- 6. Is your spouse in full agreement?
