


The light shines in the darkness and the darkness has not overcome it. John 1:5

GIVE THANKS

- Begin by fixing your eyes on Jesus and remembering the goodness of the Father
- Spend time thanking Him for who He is and what He has done

You open your hand and satisfy the desire of every living thing. The Lord is righteous in all His ways and kind in all His deeds. Psalm 145:16&17



PAUSE AND WAIT

- Ask the Holy Spirit to help you focus your time of prayer. Wait on Him to allow Him to share God's heart with you
- Ask Him to show you the ways He is present in the situations you are going to bring to Him in prayer. How is He working His good purposes out during this time of challenge?

He says, 'Be still, and know that I am God; I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth' Psalm 46:10



LET PRAYER RISE

- Begin to pray for our Nation as the Holy Spirit leads you. Be expectant that He will give you words, scriptures and pictures to guide your prayers
- The following topics and prayer points can be used as a guide where that is helpful. You may want to pray for just one or two of the topics during this time

Now let my prayer be set before you like incense; may the lifting of my hands be like the evening sacrifice. Psalm 141:2



- For wisdom, health and peace for those having to make weighty decisions in government
- For the government advisors

For lack of guidance a nation falls, but victory is won through many advisors. Proverbs 11:14



LEADERS OF OUR NATIONS



- For doctors, nurses, paramedics and support staff and all those selflessly serving our nation. In particular, for those working in intensive care wards
- For the necessary equipment, medications and protective clothing to be made available to all those who need it

The King will reply, 'Truly I tell you, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did for me.' Matthew 25:40–45



THE NHS



- For police officers, firefighters and the army
- For those working in care homes looking after the vulnerable
- For those who work in foodbanks and for increased supplies to these foodbanks

- For breakthroughs in treatment and a vaccine to be developed
- For the nations to work together with unity of purpose and mutual respect
- For the Kingdom of God to break through and defeat this virus
